The Royal Courts of Justice is reminiscent of a cathedral in both style and scale. Soaring arches and beautiful stained glass windows ornamented with the coats of arms of Lord Chancellors and keepers of the Great Seal, combined with a mosaic marble floor leading to a maze of enchanting corridors, create a majestic setting for our exciting visit to one of London's best kept secrets.

We will hear all about the architecture and fascinating history of the building as well as about the courts' most famous cases and the characters that appear in court. We will also hear about filming that has taken place here (e.g. James Bond; Mission Impossible; Bridget Jones) as well as how the high court fits into the UK justice system. The group will also get to see all of the building's most stunning rooms which appear the same today as when Queen Victoria opened the building in December 1882.

Our tour will last about 1 hour to 1 hour 15 minutes.

NATIONAL RAIL

Victoria Station – Circle & District lines stop here.

UNDERGROUND - The nearest underground stations are

Temple – Circle & District lines. 7 minute walk to courts.

Chancery Lane – Central line. 9 minute walk to courts.
